About Mission Amrit Sarovar:

The Mission Amrit Sarovar was launched with the objective to construct/rejuvenate at aleast



75 Amrit Sarovar in all the rural districts of the country. Each Amrit Sarovar having a minimum pondage area of 1 acre (0.4 hectare) with water holding capacity of 10,000 cubic meters.

Various schemes like Mahatma Gandhi NREGS, 15th Finance Commission Grants (both tied and untied), PMKSY-WDC, PMKSY-HKKP-RRR and similar schemes of the State/ Central Government supported the execution of works under the Mission. Several teams were formed at Ministry, State, District and Panchayat level to ensure the "Whole of Government" approach and to bring all the needed resources under one envelope.

At the Panchayat Level, two dedicated Prabharis for each Amrit Sarovar were positioned i.e. Panchayat Pratinidhi and Panchayat level officer and were responsible for faithful and fair execution of the Amrit Sarovar in the Panchayat while protecting the community interest.

Achievements of the Mission:

- Target for the Mission Amrit Sarovar: 50,000 (by 15th August 2023)
- Number of Amrit Sarovar completed: 68,843.
- Number of Panchayat Prabharis linked with the Mission: ~1,69,000 (including both Panchayat Pratinidhi and Panchayat Level Officer)
- Number of water user groups engaged in the Mission: ~65,000

Amrit Sarovar 2.0:

In the 44th PRAGATI meeting chaired by Hon'ble PM on 28.08.2024 held via video conference with Chief Secretaries of various States / UTs and Secretaries of various Ministries/ Departments, the Prime Minister emphasised the need to continue work on the Mission Amrit Sarovar initiative. It was directed to ensure that the water catchment areas of these *Sarovars* remain clean and that desilting of the water bodies be carried out as required, with active involvement from the local village communities.

- **3. Selection process:** There will be a three-level interview/ assessment process, the details are given below:

Level 1: Screening Interview (via phone or other virtual conference platforms: 15-30 mins)

Level 2: Technical/Skill-Based Interview (may also be via virtual conference or in-person: 45-90 mins)

- To assess technical expertise or knowledge related to the role.
- A practical assessment in the form of a test.

Level 3: Final interview with Stakeholder (Ministry officials)/ Reporting officer in-charge (in-person: 30-45 mins)

- To assess overall alignment with Government working and culture.
- To assess strategic thinking and vision.
